## Fully Automated Side Loader:



- · For residential landfill cart collection
- Saves around 6,000 gallons of diesel and reduces emissions by about 78
  metric tons of carbon dioxide equivalents annually, which is equal to removing
  12 passenger vehicles from the road

### Rear Loader:



- · For residential Clean Up Day program
- Collects recyclable household items and can accommodate large items such as non-reusable furniture

#### Flatbed:



- For Clean Up Day program and refuse cart deliveries throughout the city
- The long truck bed allows for the collection of bulky items and transport of refuse carts

#### Wash Truck



- · For commercial cart and bin washes
- Uses recycled water sourced from Palo Alto's Regional Water Quality Control Plant
- . The truck's wash system is 100% self-contained, meaning there is no runoff!

# SPECIAL EVENT WASTE STATIONS

Looking to schedule a special event this year? The City of Palo Alto requires that all special events practice zero waste through waste reduction, reuse, recycling, and composting measures. Some of these requirements include:

- Providing landfill, recycle, and compost service for the event
- Employing Zero Waste purchasing practices
  - Use compostable utensils if utensils are necessary
  - Limit single-use water bottles
  - Do not use
    - Plastic bags
    - Expanded polystyrene (Styrofoam ™) items
    - Plastic utensils, stir stick, or straws
    - Disposable decorations, including balloons
    - Pre-packaged goodie bags or individually wrapped
