According to Susan Mosqueda, “Becoming an eco-friendly establishment has brought several benefits. It has allowed us to reduce our impact on the ecosystem while creating sustainable use of organics.” Additionally, they have observed a significant reduction in their monthly waste bill. This is because recycling and organic services are much cheaper than trash services.



"At first," says Susan, "some staff thought it would take more time to separate the waste but after implementation, it was observed to take the same amount of time to clear plates." No Plastic Bags in Recycling or Organics

RECYCLING:

Reduce waste and recycle without bagging in plastic; place recyclable items straight into your recycling container loose, dry, and empty. Why? Plastic bags are wasteful and can jam up the sorting machinery at the Recycling Center.



ORGANICS:

Keep food scraps and plant trimmings loose. Why? Organics are turned into compost and put back into the soil. If you wouldn't want your food grown in it, keep it out of the organics container.

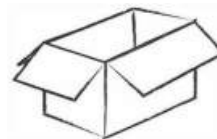

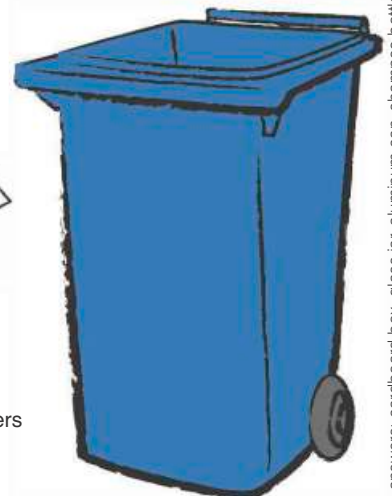
